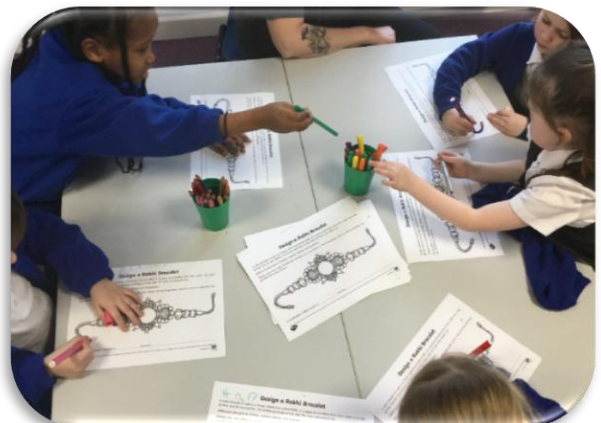

Blossom - Hindu's give each other bracelets for friendship.

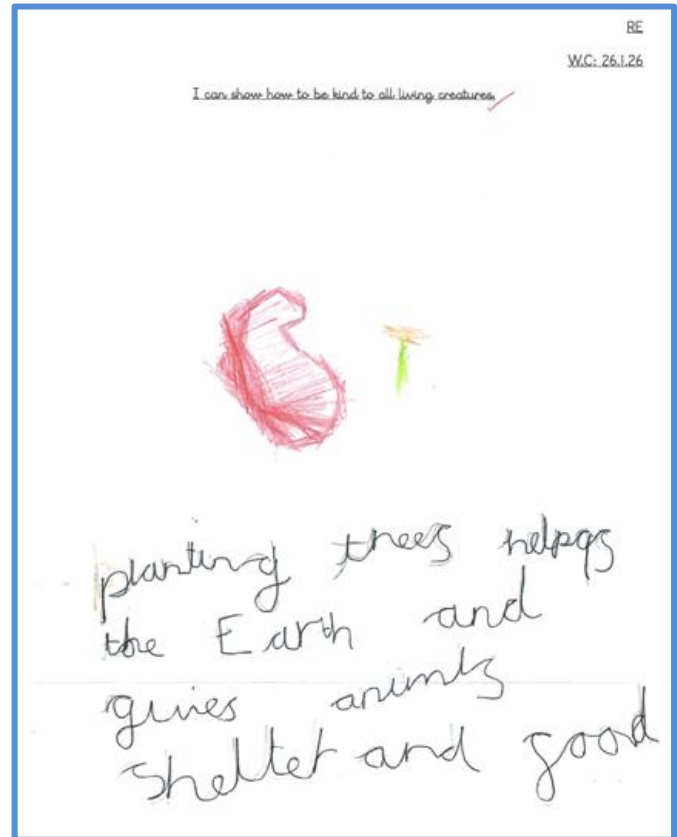
Ember - Grace is a Christian, Hannah is Jewish and Samit is Hindu. They all

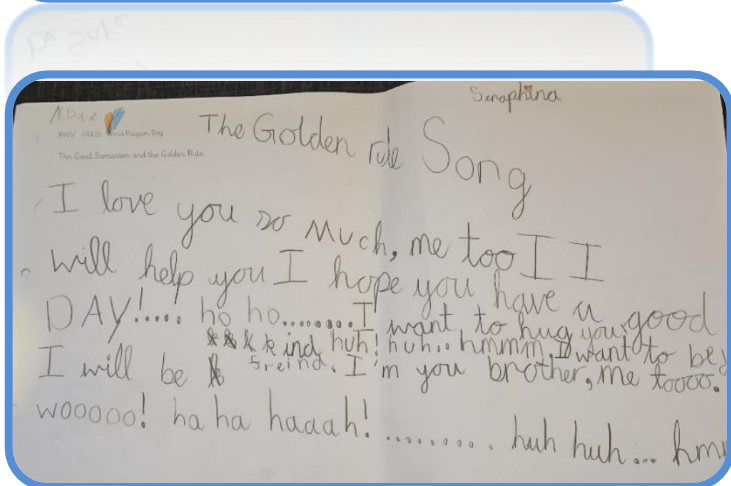
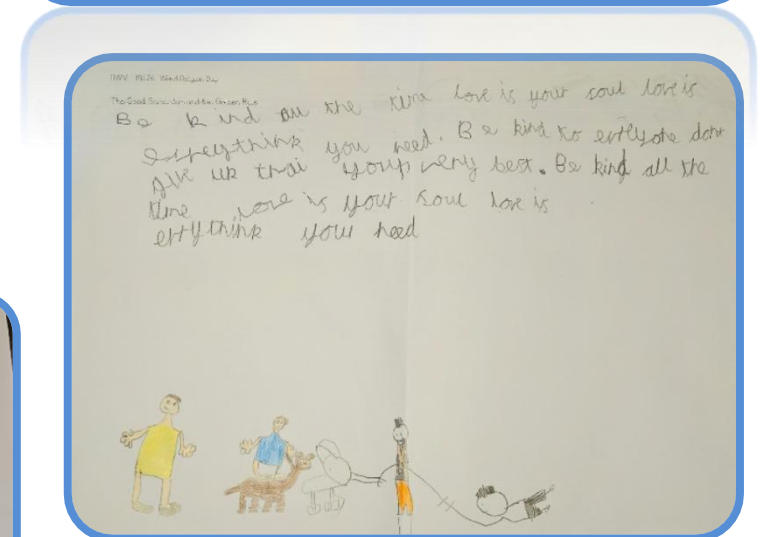
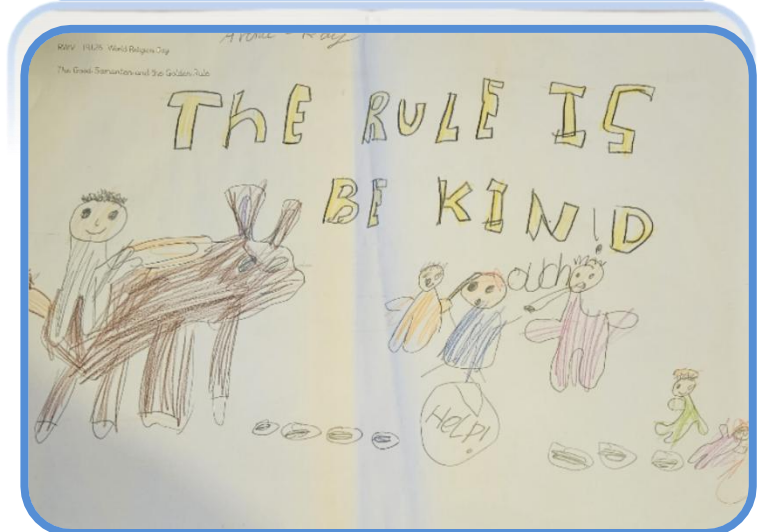
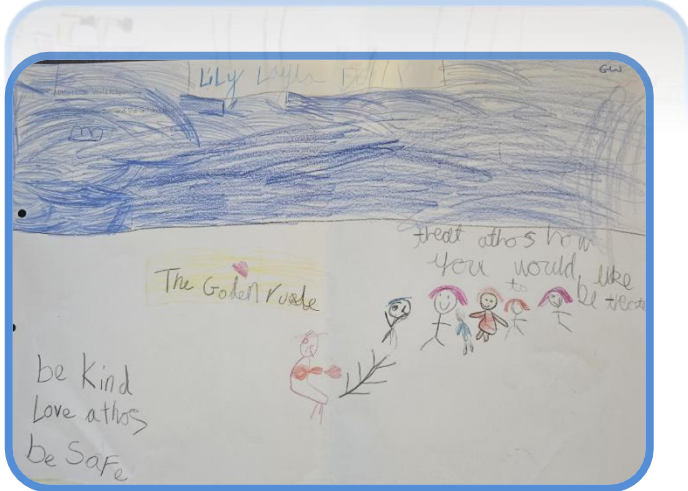
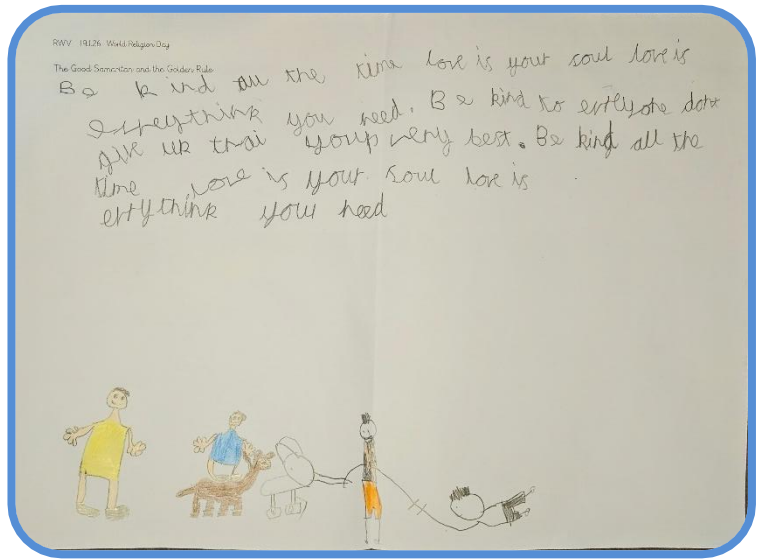
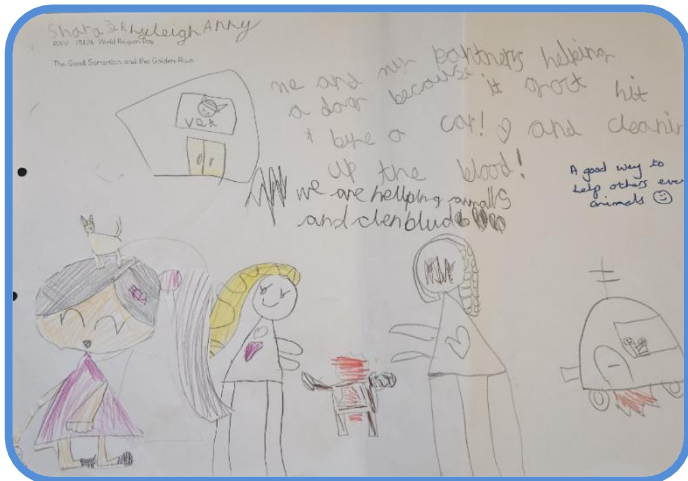
Year 1

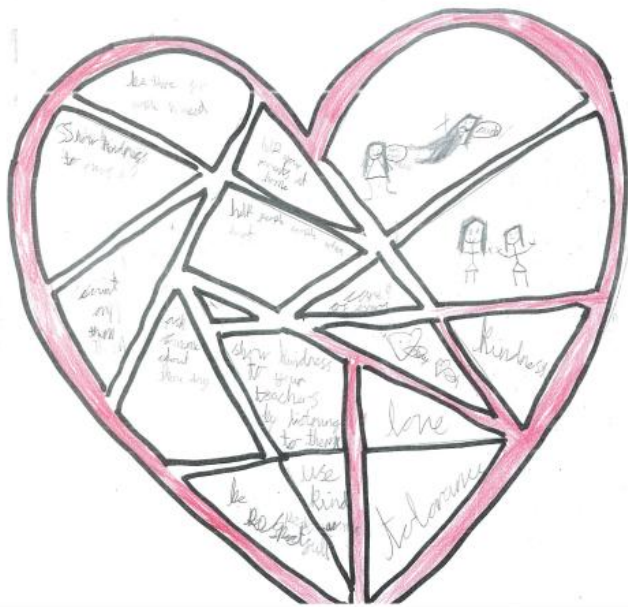


Year 2

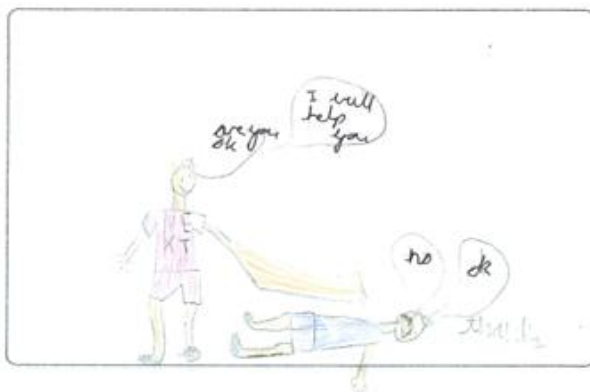

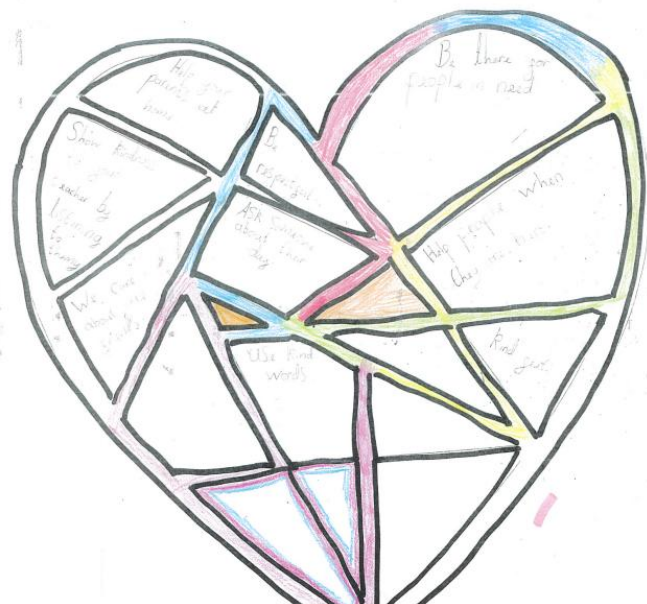

Be thankful for the things you have because they could disappear any day.

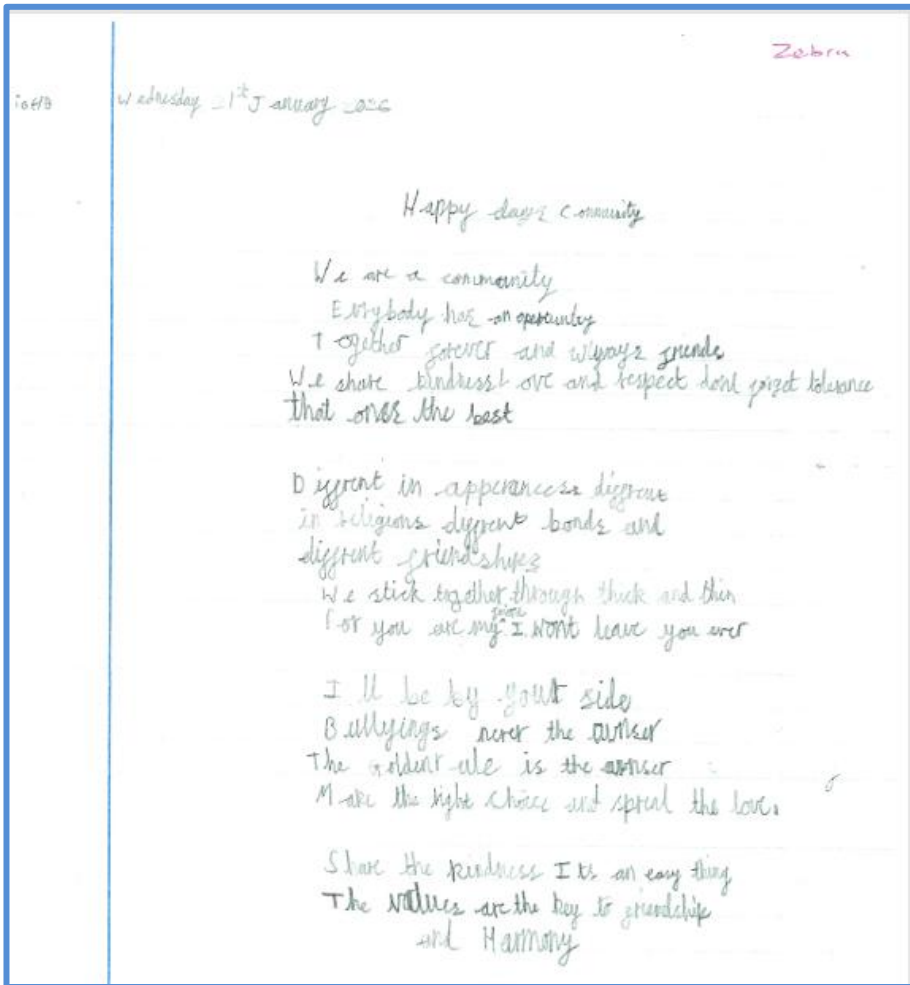

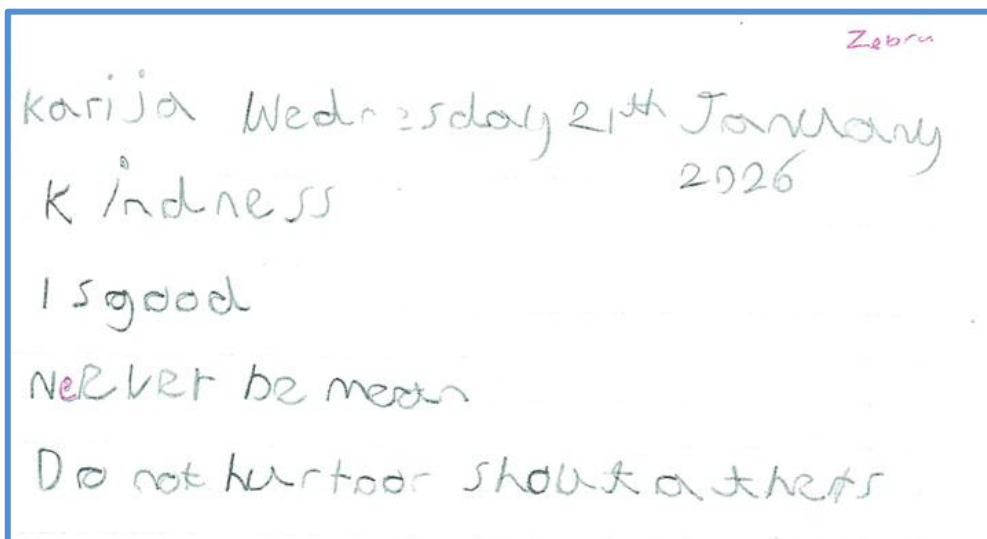
When the day has ended, we can all have some and celebrate the day with every one ~~together~~ together.

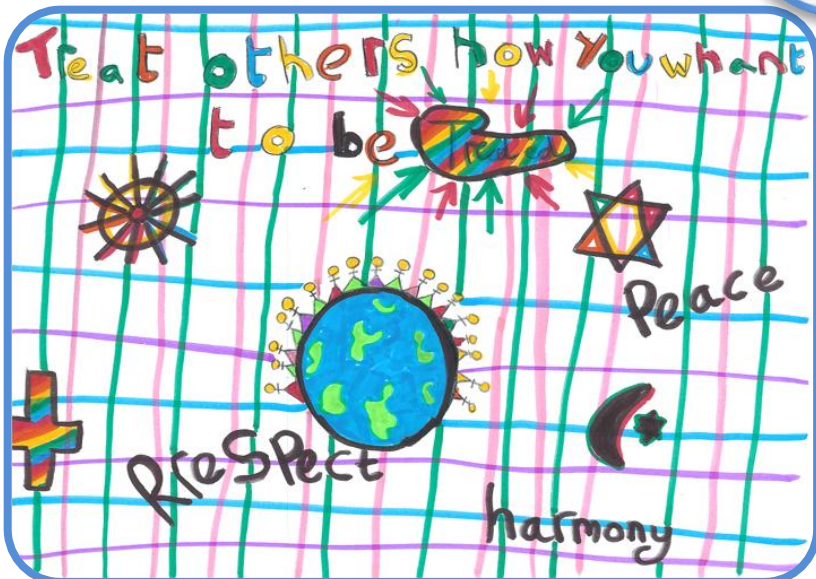
